Say goodbye to behavior charts, rewards and consequences. Instead, establish routines and build relationships to avoid “management” and create a culture where everyone has a voice and thrives.

Participants will gain knowledge and skills in:

1. rethinking management by reflecting on reward and punishment systems that may work short term but fail to build independence or decision-making skills;
2. learning routines that cultivate empathy and empower students, such as co-creating classroom norms, soft starts, calling “in” hurtful comments, and teaching problem-solving;
3. identifying the value of strong relationships with and among students and gain strategies such as identity webs, the dot activity, finding common ground with caregivers, and more.
