Behavioral challenges can occur in any classroom setting. The key to changing these behaviors is to understand why they are occurring and then implementing interventions which address that function. This in person inservice will provide a basic/general overview of ABA strategies and principles and will present how to identify the function of an inappropriate social behavior and then discuss interventions that can be used based on the different functions.

Participants will gain knowledge and skills in:

1. the function of a behavior,
2. interventions that can be used in the classroom to address the different functions of a challenging behavior.
