This in person inservice is intended for teams of individuals (administrators, teachers, counselors and support staff) who are seeking to deepen their equity lens - those who will be supporting and leading equity efforts in their schools and districts. Educational equity occurs when every student has access to the educational resources and rigor they need at the right moment in their education. Implicit bias, how it originated, and how these biases impact behaviors and relationships with students, their families, and educators' colleagues will be examined. The importance of beginning an internal examination of our own identities and unearned advantages will be explored. Participants will move from understanding terms, concepts and behaviors to a more action-oriented approach of using equity audits to collect and analyze data.

Participants will gain knowledge and skills in:

1. understanding the concept of implicit/unconscious bias, how it negatively impacts our ability to connect with others and how it manifests in the classroom,
2. exploring the concept of unearned advantage/disadvantage (privilege) and understanding why exploring privilege helps us dismantle inequities in the educational setting.
