As a result of the protests, riots, and various social movements throughout the country, districts are face challenging situations balancing the need for discipline, both off and on campus, against students' First Amendment rights. A detailed analysis of the U.S. Supreme Court Case, Mahanoy Area School Dist. v. B.L. will provide district administrators with some changed guidance and direction in this area during this online inservice.
