This inservice focuses on the actual methods and applications of best practices in the area of social-emotional and character development (SECD). Regardless of the SECD program currently being implemented, if at all, participants will become better equipped to implement a wide range of SECD instructional and implementation methods. Specifically, participants will explore the role of emotions and emotion regulation in student success and what effective and evidence based SECD instruction looks like in the classroom.

Participants will gain knowledge and skills in:

1. the relationship between academic achievement and the development of social-emotional competencies;
2. SECD skills and mindsets students need to be successful socially and academically;
3. pedagogical strategies to integrate SECD principles, skills and concepts into all aspects of teaching;
4. initiating and operating a SECD friendly classroom or group.
