These "quickwrites" require little to no advanced planning, can be used in any subject area, and, best of all, will not have you lugging any papers home to grade! Walk away with a bank of prompts that can be used to increase engagement and participation in class activities, encourage students to reflect on their growth and the feedback you regularly provide, and build student accountability for learning.

Participants will gain knowledge and skills in:

1. easy-to-use writing tasks that increase classroom participation and engagement aligning writing expectations to the current standards and existing scoring rubrics,
2. explicitly guiding students in reflecting on their learning and the feedback you provide them on their work,
3. using "quickwrites" to increase student accountability while decreasing your own workload,
4. planning specific prompts to enable immediate classroom implementation of workshop strategies.
