Reviewing the New Jersey Department of Education’s guidance related to school reopening can be overwhelming, leaving many administrators with more questions than answers, especially when it comes to students with disabilities. The impact of COVID-19 school closures and districts’ legal obligations under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) will be examined. Issues include compliance with IEPs within shortened school days, compensatory education, and remote services. This online inservice will review the guidance and best practices in terms of how a school district is to proceed with its obligations to students under the IDEA.
