Strategies that are based on the principles of applied behavior analysis (ABA) can be used to enhance the skill development of various individuals. Implementing interventions to increase appropriate social and academic skills can increase student achievement in other areas. This online inservice will provide a basic/general overview of ABA strategies and principles and will present various interventions that can increase appropriate social and academic behaviors/skills.

1. interventions, based on ABA principles, that can be used to increase student academic skills;
2. interventions, based on ABA principles, that can be used to increase student social skills.
