There are several components that must go into designing an effective RTI model to provide students with individualized support. Those include a district-wide assessment plan, assessment calendar, and strategy for reviewing and incorporating data to design effective tiered intervention plans. This in person inservice will focus on the steps necessary to designing a model based on data.

Participants will gain knowledge and skills in:

1. understanding the difference between normed-reference and criterion-referenced assessments;
2. identifying assessments that can be used as a universal screening tool in reading and math;
3. creating a district-wide assessment calendar;
4. developing a data-based decision-making plan of action;
5. deploying a data team to analyze data at a variety of levels (grade level, school level, district level);
6. using data to develop individualized student action plans.
