Students who are below grade level require instructional practices that help them achieve more than one year's growth in one year's time. During this interactive in person inservice, participants will learn how to examine the impact of factors that influence student outcomes, identify practices with a high effect size, and increase use of instructional strategies that accelerate learning. Practical techniques and resources to improve the use of five high impact practices that optimize student outcomes (student talk, thinking tasks, teacher clarify, assessment and feedback) will be shared.

Participants will gain knowledge and skills in:

1. strategies for engaging students in rigorous thinking tasks and productive classroom conversations,
2. protocols for using local assessments to improve students' performance on high stakes assessments,
3. techniques for using three kinds of feedback to develop more successful and self-reliant learners,
4. ways to use clear learning intentions and explicit success criteria to help teachers and students assess students' progress and performance.
