Figuring out when tiered intervention needs to shift to special education means recognizing what educators' roles and processes are within a district. During this in person inservice, how the roles of child study team members change, along with those of related service providers/therapists will be addressed. What happens when a student is not considered eligible for special education, but has not made adequate progress in Tier 3 - and vice versa will also be addressed. The integration of RTI and special education processes will be the focus of this inservice.

Participants will gain knowledge and skills in:

1. describing an RTI model and learning how special education is integrated throughout the multi-tiers of support,
2. analyzing RTI data and making data-based decisions on moving students from tiers to special education,
3. determining roles and responsibilities of the special education staff members in the RTI process including child study team members and related service providers.
