Re: Annual Re-Notification as required by AHERA

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) 40 CFR 763 requires all schools from pre-k to Grade 12 to conduct inspections to determine if they contain asbestos containing building materials (ACBM). If they do, the ACBM must be categorized according to the type of material, its locations, current damage, and its potential for future damage and a detailed Asbestos Management Plan must be developed. The Management Plan details the inspection findings, and outlines the response actions the MUJC Board of Education (Board) intends to implement.

To accomplish these goals, the Board has on file at each school and in the District Office a NJ State Department of Health approved asbestos Management Plan for all school facilities. The provisions of the plan are being implemented in a timely and ongoing fashion. The Board will also schedule and perform 3-year re-inspections and 6-month surveillance as required by the AHERA regulations. It is your Board's desire to provide a safe and healthy facility for all students, employees and visitors.
