At times, other criteria influence students’ academic achievements. This inservice will explore how educators and support staff teach students to become self regulated learners. 1. recognizing the obstacles students present with proactive responsive instruction that differentiates the methods, materials, and classroom designs;
2. exploring ways to infuse visual, auditory and kinesthetic instructional approaches to learners across the curriculum;
3. establishing classrooms that value students as collaborative partners who are skilled motivated learners;
4. differentiating the planning and lessons with individual student profiles that meet students’ academic, perceptual, social, emotional and behavioral levels.
